Respite: Short Breaks for Family Caregivers

A Family Caregiver is someone who cares for a person of any age who has a condition or disability that requires help and care. Family caregivers can be parents, children, other relatives, guardians or foster parents, neighbors, and friends.

Respite services can include:

- In-home services
- Recreation
- Day and overnight camps
- Out-of-home day programs
- Retreats
- 24-hr care
- Classes
- Therapeutic programs
- Other similar options.
